

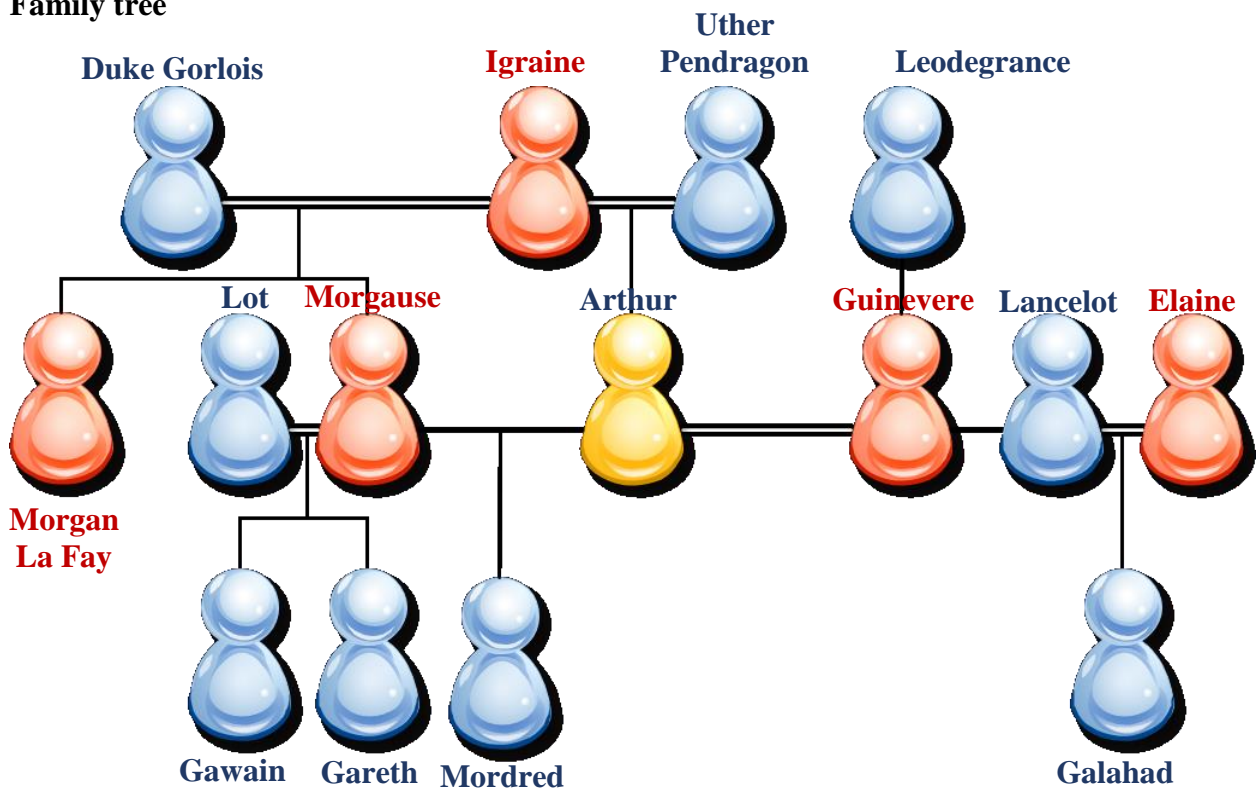

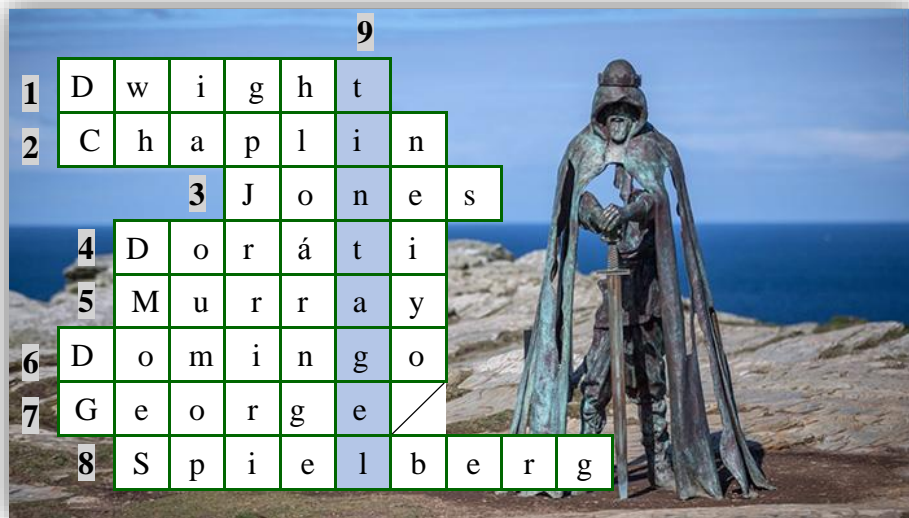
1 King Arthur and his fellows had really complicated relationships. Browse the internet for information and match the names with the numbers.

- 2 British comedian in the era of silent film. In his films he usually wore a black suit and a hat. Queen Elisabeth made him a knight in 1975. He was 85, sitting in a wheelchair.
- 3 A Welsh singer born in 1940. He was knighted in 2006 for his services to music. His famous songs are She's a Lady, Delilah.
- 4 Composer and conductor who was born in Budapest, died in Switzerland. He was made a knight in 1983.
- 5 Tennis player, became Britain's youngest knight of modern times in 2016.
- 6 Spanish opera singer, one of The Three Tenors. He was knighted in 2002.
- 7 The youngest knight in history was Prince ...**George**... who became a knight at the age of three in 1765. (He's the odd-one-out in this crossword, as he's not a modern knight. 😊)
- 8 An American, director of Jurassic Park, Hook. He was knighted in 2001 for his great job in the entertainment industry.

...**Tintagel**..... is the legendary ..... **birthplace/castle** .....of King Arthur.

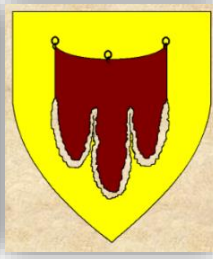

In this task you can find the shields of Arthur and 12 of his knights. Match the names of the knights with their shields.



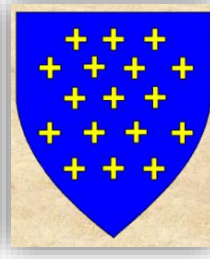
